APPROVAL OF CONTRACT

BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a AT&T Southeast

**WHEREAS**, the City of Selma, Alabama (*the "City"*) is the recipient of a \$400,000.00 Omnibus Appropriation through the Alabama Department of Transportation for the relocation of overhead utilities to underground in two blocks of Water Avenue; *and*

**WHEREAS**, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a AT&T Southeast has reviewed the proposed scope of work and submitted a proposal to the City, and following careful review, along with a professional engineering firm, the City has chosen the option to have BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a AT&T Southeast remove aerial cable and associated drops in the first block of Water Avenue from Broad Street to Washington Street, replace with a buried cable in existing ducts at a cost of \$29,288.27; *and*

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the City Council of the City of Selma, Alabama that:

George Evans, in his capacity as Mayor, is hereby authorized to execute a contract in the amount of \$29,288.27 with BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a AT&T Southeast, pending ALDOT approval, for relocation of overhead utilities to underground in the first block of Water Avenue; *and*

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** said contract expenses shall be reimbursable from the Alabama Department of Transportation.
